

ApplyTexas Application

The ApplyTexas Application is the admissions application for all Texas public universities, as well as for health-related and independent institutions that contract to use it. The ApplyTexas Application is designed to make applying to every Texas public university plus some private and two-year schools easier (see website or paper application for complete list of schools that use the ApplyTexas Application). Institutions prefer that you apply online at www.applytexas.org; however, you may print the application by going to www.collegefortexans.com, click on “Applying for College”, and then “ApplyTexas Application” to print information needed. Students may fill out one application online and apply to as many of the Texas schools as they wish, as long as the student pays the application fee charged by each institution. Majors and codes used on the application are available on the website and in the *Code Book*, available at <http://www.collegefortexans.com>.
