CONDUCT AT SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

IF A PPHS STUDENT BREAKS ANY SCHOOL AND/OR DISTRICT RULE, THE STUDENT MAY BE HELD RESPONSIBLE.

Dress code guidelines will be honored at all school events and dances. The following will apply:

- 1 - This is a formal wear event.
- 2 - No revealing clothing may be worn including clothing where excessive cleavage is displayed.
- 3 - All wraps, coats or covers will be removed before entering the dance.
- 4 - No clothing cut down to the navel or below the top of the breast line.
- 5 - No apparel that exposes the posterior.
- 6 - No see through clothing.
- 7 - No bare midriff.
- 8 - No sagging pants.
- 9 - No displaying of undergarments of any kind.
- 10 - No clothing or jewelry that is sexually explicit.
- 11 - No clothing or jewelry that would create animosity between groups, is gang-like in nature, or is offensive or dangerous to others.
- 12 - No outside food or drink can be brought into the event.

Modesty and “Good Taste” are the keys.

Students who are in violation will not be admitted and will not receive a refund. If you have questions regarding attire, please get prior approval from your administrator.

Dance movements and mannerisms must fall within the standards of social acceptability and good taste. Dancing commonly referred to as “Freak Dancing” or movements which depict private acts, are sexually suggestive or are a distraction or bothersome to others are not allowed. Physically dangerous dancing, such as slamming or moshing, is not allowed.

At all school functions and activities, any consumption or possession of a controlled substance or alcohol shall be punished by the exclusion from that activity and further activities sponsored by the associated Student Body. The administrators/chaperones, in charge, have the authority to apply these rules. Students will also be subject to district disciplinary regulations including suspension and/or expulsion.

Any infraction of PPHS school rules and regulations shall result in the student's parents being contacted. The student may be asked to leave with their parents. In some cases, violators may be subject to criminal prosecution. Students may be suspended pending an investigation of their infraction/incident. Anyone not admitted to an event or removed from an event due to a violation of these rules will not be given a refund.
