

Pilot Point High School Summer School 2010

Pilot Point High School Summer School is available for students who have failed a course, lost credit due to attendance, or wish to accelerate coursework. PPHS Summer School will utilize OdysseyWare, which is a self-paced, individualized, online curriculum.

The summer school program will be held June 9-June 30, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; bus transportation is provided to bus eligible students. PPHS Summer School will meet on the Pilot Point Elementary School campus in the library; all coursework must be completed on campus. Breakfast and lunch will be served free of charge for any person living in the school district who is 18 years old or younger.

Summer School enrollment is limited and will be taken on a first-come, first-sign-up basis, so apply early; applications must be approved by the HS counselor/administrator. Applications received after a session has reached capacity, will be placed on a wait list and called if an opening becomes available.

Students attending the summer school program must comply with the Pilot Point ISD dress code and be in attendance each day. Punctual and regular attendance is **REQUIRED**. You will be expected to arrive for class on time and remain in class the entire period; no tardies and no leaving early. You may be dropped on the second absence, and someone on the waiting list may take your spot.

To receive credit, students must earn 70% mastery on courses previously attempted or 80% mastery on courses for acceleration. The student is responsible for the cost of the course enrolled in: *Recovery Courses* - \$25 per semester course (1/2 credit); *Acceleration Courses* - \$50 per semester course (1/2 credit); the course fee may be waived for students eligible for free or reduced lunch. Students may sign up for one course at a time.
